No. 10 YUCCA gloriosa 'Variegata'

Description

·Variegation of Leaf_- Creamy leaf margins. In the cooler months the plant will have visible pink to reddish overtones.

Grows to about 5' in height by 4' in width.

•Flowers - Creamy white flowers in summer months that last for several weeks.

Outdoor Growth

- ·Light Full sun
- ·Water Low water needs, drought and heat tolerant. DOES NOT LIKE WET "FEET".


Specimen product that will not form a trunk but will remain compact and form extra shoots. Slow growing and really tolerant of difficult growing situations: cold, heat, dry conditions and high sun areas.

•Soil_- Well drained mix but a dry mix is best. pH is a bit acidic - 6.0.
