

Pandanus



VEITCHII

- Larger Pandanus also suitable for exterior in Tropical areas.
- Cuttings are best potted up in 15 or 17 cm (6 or 7 inch) pots and repotted in larger ones.
- When given enough space it will break side shoots easily.



BABILONENSIS

- Smaller Pandanus with a lovely shape.
- Will tolerate very high light intensity.
- Has some sensitivity to spider mite.
- Easy care.
- Holds up well in darker interior.
- Light well draining soil.????
- Cuttings are to be potted up in 10 -12cm (4-5 inch) pots and if desired, repotted in maximum 20 cm (8 inch).
- Will not grow much larger.



AMARYLLIFOLIUS

- Smaller pandanus with just green foliage.
- Used in the Asian kitchen and gives its name to the “Pandan-rice”
- Suited for 5 and 6 inch pots.
- In bigger pots one will have to work with multiple cuttings per pot as the growth habit is columnary.
- Grows quite fast upward
- Can be treated with PGR’s like Bonzi.
