

# EPIPREMNUM & PICTUS

## Dave's Tips



**PLANT NAME:** EPIPREMNUM & PICTUS

**PRODUCT FORM:** Leaf & Vine, Vine, Cell Packs

Pothos is a group of vining, trailing or climbing plants. It's most commonly used as an indoor houseplant but it can be used as a landscape plant in temperate zones.

**HARDINESS ZONE(S):** 10-11

**LIGHT LEVELS/INTENSITY:** Best grown in in 2,500-3,000 foot candles, with the exception of the variety Neon, which needs much lower light, about 1,000-2,000.

**FERTILIZER:** N-P-K Ratio: 3-1-2 is adequate with minor elements, especially Calcium, Magnesium and Iron.

**DISEASES:** Bacterial Leaf Spot, Erwinia, Pseudomonas, Pythium, Rhizoctonia, Southern Blight

**POTENTIAL PESTS:** Caterpillars, Mealy Bugs, Spider Mites, Scale and Thrips

### SOIL MIXTURE

Use a well aerated, good drainage peat based soil and let dry before re-watering.

### WATER

Allow to dry between waterings. Over watering can cause the plants to weaken and experience disease problems.

### HUMIDITY

Tolerant of a wide range of humidity, but higher humidity along with temperatures 70-80 F are ideal.



### Growth Rates

Fast growing in proper greenhouse growing conditions.

- 4" Pots  
10-12 wks
- 6" Inch Pots  
14-16 wks
- 8" Hanging Baskets  
16-20 wks
- 10" Hanging Baskets  
18-22 wks
